**10** EVERY angler needs a waterproof bag to keep all that expensive kit dry, so the new range of water resistant GRXi luggage might well be what you're after.

The bags are made from a tough and durable, wipe-clean tarpaulin fabric that Greys describe as having "high water resistance". In my view, it's better than water resistant and is about as close to 'waterproof' as you can get, fending off driving rain, waves and water sloshing around in the bottom of the boat. The bag has a waterproof moulded and hardwearing base that not only keeps everything dry but also protects the contents from knocks.

The bags come in three sizes with the largest (on review) measuring 60 x 30 x 35cm and weighing in at 3.20kg. It has a large main storage compartment that can be further sectioned up with padded internal dividers for a customised layout. The bag is roomy enough to accommodate a regular sized flask standing upright. A full width zipped mesh pocket on the inside of the lid can be used for a range of accessories. The lid is secured with a heavy-duty double zip and actually overlaps the whole of the bag helping to keep it dry. Additional features include an adjustable and detachable padded shoulder strap, double carry handles, two padded grab handles, four D-rings and rod tube holder straps.
